Attendance

It is so important for you child to come to class every day. We make the most of our learning time, and every day is full of important skills that build on one another. Homework

Homework will be sent home each Monday and returned on Fridays. Homework consists of practicing reading fluency. Reading every day at home will help improve fluency, listening skills, inflection, and so much more! Be on the lookout for homework folders in September. I will be sure to communicate with you once they are sent home.

Grading

Grades will be weighted as follows:

- Homework 5%
- Classwork 10%
- Class Participation 10%
- Spelling Assessments 25%
- Vocabulary Assessments 25%
- Comprehension Assessments 25%

Behavior

Creating a classroom that is rich in learning as well as safe for all students is my top priority. In order for the classroom to function properly and efficiently, rules must be demonstrated, taught, practiced, and enforced. The rules in my classroom are direct and simple:

- Be respectful to everyone and everything (students, teachers, equipment, etc.)
- Listen when others are talking. Wait your turn to talk.
- Stay on task.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.

My classroom behavior plan focuses on positive reinforcement. Students will earn class dojo points for following the classroom rules and showing exemplary behavior. Every 10 points the students earn, they receive a prize of their choice! They also earn class parties when the class is modeling correct behavior.

If a student does not follow the classroom rules, the following consequences will be put into effect depending on the severity and frequency of the behavior:

- Verbal warning
- Loss of class dojo point
- Contact parent
- Sent to another classroom
- Sent to administration

If there is ever an issue with the behavior policy or the enforcement thereof, please contact me. Communication is key to resolving any misunderstandings or conflicts. Please know that we are all a TEAM: you, me, and your child. We all want what is best for your child.
